### 2024 INFINITI QX60 pricing starts at \$59,195

**MISSISSAUGA, Ont.** – The 2024 INFINITI QX60 is a compelling choice for families seeking an elevated level of luxury, with seating for up to seven, beautiful design inside and out, and an abundance of premium technologies. The 2024 INFINITI QX60 arrived in showrooms with a starting MSRP<sup>1</sup> of \$59,195.

New this year for the QX60, and all other 2024 INFINITI models and grades sold in Canada, is an extended four-year complimentary INFINITI InTouch™ Services Premium package that provide the luxuries of navigation, security, keyless entry features, in-car Wi-Fi and entertainment – all in a single, innovative, in-dash system. This is coupled with the added convenience of the [Oil Change & Tire Rotation Plan](#)<sup>1</sup>, an integrated maintenance program that provides up to four years or 80,000 kilometers (whichever occurs first) of oil changes and tire rotations.

The 2024 INFINITI QX60 offers buyers a choice of four appealing grades, all of which are equipped with INFINITI Intelligent All-Wheel Drive<sup>2</sup>. For added reassurance, every QX60 features a standard suite of active safety technology including Forward Emergency Braking with Pedestrian Detection, Rear Automatic Braking, Blind Spot Warning, Lane Departure Warning and High Beam Assist.

The QX60 PURE starts at \$59,195 MSRP and is generously equipped with leather-appointed first- and second-row seating, 18-inch aluminum-alloy wheels, INFINITI InTouch™ with a 12.3-inch high definition interactive display featuring wireless Apple CarPlay® and USB-based Android Auto™, a wireless phone charging pad, a panoramic moonroof, heated front seats and a power liftgate.

For the QX60 LUXE (\$63,195), key enhancements include 20-inch aluminum-alloy wheels, silver roof rails, silver metallic weave interior trim, Around View® Monitor with Moving Object



Detection, Remote Engine Start, climate-controlled front seats, INFINITI 12.3-inch Dynamic Meter Display for the driver and additional driver assistance in the form of [ProPILOT Assist](#) with Navi-link<sup>3</sup>.

The QX60 SENSORY (\$68,795) rewards buyers with additions including massaging front seats, heated second-row seats, illuminated front and rear kickplates, enhanced interior ambient lighting, a premium smooth leather-wrapped steering wheel, black open-pore ash wood trim, a motion-activated lift gate and a Bose® Performance series 17-speaker audio system. The Sensory trim is also equipped with an enhanced tow-package which provides the vehicle the ability to up to 6,000 lbs. Additional equipment includes a 10.8-inch head-up display and a camera-based Smart Rear View Mirror<sup>4</sup>.

Exemplifying the best of INFINITI design, the QX60 AUTOGRAPH (\$71,795) includes second-row captain's chairs with removable center console, a Black Obsidian roof with black roof rails and semi-aniline leather seating (first and second rows) with quilting, perforation and contrasting stitching.
