2025 INFINITI QX55 pricing starts at \$57,675

MISSISSAUGA, Ont. – The 2025 INFINITI QX55 stands out with daring styling, a meticulously crafted interior and abundant technologies to make every drive more convenient. Unchanged for the 2025 model year, the QX55 arrives in showrooms this month with a starting MSRP¹ of \$57,675.

The 2025 INFINITI QX55 offers buyers a choice of three highly equipped grades, each featuring the standard confidence of INFINITI Intelligent All-Wheel Drive². Adding further reassurance, every QX55 features a standard suite of active safety technology including Forward Emergency Braking with Pedestrian Detection³, Rear Automatic Braking⁴, Blind Spot Warning and Intervention⁵, Lane Departure Warning and Prevention⁶ and High Beam Assist.

The 2025 INFINITI QX55 LUXE starts at \$57,675 MSRP and rewards clients with a powerful yet efficient⁷ 2.0-liter Variable Compression Turbo (VC-Turbo) engine rated for 268 horsepower and 280 lb-ft of torque, 20-inch wheels, a leather-wrapped steering wheel, ProPILOT Assist⁸, heated front seats, a wireless phone charging pad and INFINITI InTouch™ infotainment featuring Android Auto™ and wireless Apple CarPlay®⁹.

Finally, the 2025 QX55 SENSORY has a starting MSRP of \$63,675 and builds on the highly equipped ESSENTIAL grade with black natural maple open-pore wood interior trim, enhanced interior ambient lighting, metallic cargo area trim plates, a head-up display, a motion-activated liftgate, semi-aniline leather-appointed seating and heated rear seats.
